

## **Project Manager (Property)**

The Project Manager will develop relationships across the business to ensure that purchases are aligned to need and whilst not essential, we are keen to hear from individuals who have experience within the residential property market in Scotland. This role is based at our Central Office in Glasgow, there will be travel across the geographical regions that we operate including East Lothian and Argyll and Bute.

## MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Overall management of the Project including scope of works and other project implementation documents.
- 2. Conduct market research of the property market which will include market trends, property valuations, refurbishment needs etc. across various geographic locations
- 3. Oversee the project implementation team (matrix management), chairing regular meetings and providing regular highlight reports and performance information to the group
- 4. Highlighting Risk and Issues, determining mitigation plans where necessary.
- 5. Participation at Steering Committee, preparing papers and reports for Senior Management and Board.
- 6. Generating investment recommendations for approval by SLT based on set purchasing criteria
- 7. Engage with estate agents, private sectors owner and other potential sellers to determine availability and suitability of properties.
- 8. Execute and monitor the investment delivery against set targets which include volume, frequency of purchase, price, refurb costs etc.
- 9. Update systems and portal with new purchase information
- 10. Engage with Solicitors through the conveyancing process, bringing



comments, suggestions or issues to the project team for collaborative discussion and solution.

11. To work collaboratively with other offices and attend internal meetings as appropriate
